(SUN PRAIRIE) — Representative Gary Hebl (D-Sun Prairie) announced today that he will be running for re-election in November 2020 to continue representing the 46th Assembly District.

“I couldn’t be more proud of my progressive legislative record,” Hebl said. “Since my first day in the Capitol, I have worked tirelessly to defend working class families, fund public education, ensure affordable healthcare, and protect our environment.”
