Walker's Road to Nowhere

(MADISON) – Despite overwhelming evidence that the state's infrastructure is decaying, that didn't stop Governor Scott Walker from dipping into the Department of Transportation's funds to redirect \$90 million dollars towards Foxconn, a project that is already costing Wisconsin taxpayers roughly \$4.5 billion.

In response to the announcement, Senator Lena Taylor (D-Milwaukee) released the following statement:

"It's par for the course to see another one of Walker's campaign promises crumble at a rate only matched by the Governor's ability to quickly make another one. It saddens me that the taxpayer money set aside for the basic necessities of our state, from crucial state highways to the roads we teach our children to drive on, is being put towards Walker's pet project.
