

Representative Rohrkaste Announces Re-Election Run

Neenah-State Representative Mike Rohrkaste (R-Neenah) is announcing he's running for another term in the Wisconsin State Assembly to represent the 55th Assembly District.

"It's a privilege to serve the residents of the Fox Cities and Wisconsin," said Rep. Rohrkaste. "I enjoy working on your behalf to make our community an even better place to live, work, and enjoy life."

Rep. Rohrkaste has been a Neenah resident for over twenty years, and was formerly a human resources executive for Menasha and Oshkosh Corporations.
