Charlotte Gibson -- Director of the Division of Legal Services

Gibson graduated from the University of Michigan Law School, magna cum laude, in 1999 and received her bachelor's degree from Princeton University, summa cum laude, in 1990. She clerked on the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Fifth Circuit for Judge Patrick Higginbotham.

Tina Virgil - Director of the Division of Law Enforcement Services

Virgil most recently served as Director of the Special Investigations Bureau, overseeing critical-incident response for officer-involved shootings. She also held the position of the State Fire Marshal. Virgil has been with the Wisconsin Department of Justice for 26 years. She received her Bachelor of Science in criminal justice and psychology from Edgewood College and also graduated from Northwestern University School of Police Staff and Command.
