Sen. Howard Marklein Sworn-In for Another Four Year Term

Madison, WI – Senator Howard Marklein (R-Spring Green) was sworn-in for another four-year term today on the floor of the State Senate. The Senate Inauguration was held at 2 p.m.

"I am honored to be representing the residents of the 17th Senate District for another four years in the State Senate," Marklein said. "I am looking forward to serving those I represent, leading legislation that makes a difference, championing rural issues, defending our reforms and continuing to watch the state's checkbook."
