**Statement on Governor Evers' Budget**

Tonight Governor Evers proposed a budget that reflects Wisconsin values and will effectively lead our great state forward.

For too long, our state's infrastructure has been neglected leading to some of the worst bridge and road conditions in the nation. Governor Evers' budget paves the way towards the sound investment in our transportation network that is safe, effective, while creating and sustaining family supporting jobs.

For eight years, worker protections and policies that supported a stable construction industry have been eliminated and political attacks have been directed at workers who stand together. This budget proposes to fix the ill-advised partisan policies that hurt worker training, create an influx of untrained out of state workers, and hurt Wisconsin families.

We commend Governor Evers on his budget proposal and hope the legislature will recognize the importance of supporting Wisconsin workers and families.
