Wisconsin Joins Lawsuit Against Pres. Trump's Fake National Emergency

MADISON, WI – On Wednesday, Governor Tony Evers and Attorney General Josh Kaul jointly announced that Wisconsin would join the multistate lawsuit challenging President Donald Trump's national emergency declaration, an unconstitutional attempt to bypass Congress and reallocate billions of taxpayer dollars to pay for a U.S-Mexico border wall. Representative Greta Neubauer (D-Racine) released the following statement in support of this decision:

"Since his election in 2016, President Donald Trump has worked to manufacture a 'crisis' at the border, pitting Americans against each other and pushing for a multibillion dollar border wall. Last month, he declared a false 'national emergency,' attempting to reallocate billions of dollars for a border wall in violation of our Constitutional separation of powers," Neubauer said.

"Wisconsin was the third state to challenge the crisis manufactured by the Trump administration, bringing our National Guard troops home. I'm proud to support Governor Evers and Attorney General Josh Kaul in their decision to join the multistate lawsuit against this executive overreach. It's past time for comprehensive immigration reform, and not just presidential showmanship, exaggeration, and discrimination," Neubauer concluded.
