## **PSC Chair Valcq Announces Commissioner's Office Appointments**

MADISON – Public Service Commission of Wisconsin Chairperson Rebecca Cameron Valcq (pronounced "Vock") announced the appointments of Carrie Templeton as her Chief of Staff and Matt Dannenberg as Communications and Legislative Director. On January 7, 2019, Governor Tony Evers appointed Cameron Valcq to a six-year term as a Commissioner. Governor Evers' appointment of Cameron Valcq as Chairperson of the Commission was effective on March 2, 2019. She is the first Latina to hold this position.

Chairperson Cameron Valcq appointed Carrie Templeton as her Executive Assistant in January, and as her Chief of Staff effective March 2. This is the first time two women have led the Commission's management team. Templeton has twenty years of management experience at several state agencies, including eight years at the Commission prior to her appointment. Templeton also worked in management roles at the Departments of Corrections, Revenue, and Financial Institutions, as well as in the Governor's office and Wisconsin State Senate. Templeton earned her undergraduate and Master's of Public Administration and Policy Analysis degrees from UW-Madison. She lives in McFarland with her two sons.

Matt Dannenberg is a member of Bad River Band of Lake Superior Chippewa and a proud Watertown Gosling. During college, he interned in the State Assembly for two years handling natural resource issues. For the last nine years, Dannenberg held various positions at Wisconsin Conservation Voters, which is a nonpartisan, non-profit organization advocating for pro-conservation public policy. Dannenberg graduated from UW-Madison with a bachelor's degree in Political Science and Environmental Studies. He lives in Wauwatosa with his fiancé Emma.
