## Oneida Tribal Chairman Delivers State of Tribes Address to Legislature

**Madison...**Today, Oneida Tribal Nation Chairman Tehassi Hill delivered the Wisconsin State of the Tribes address to the State Assembly and Senate. This speech is an annual tradition whereby a leader of one of Wisconsin's 11 federally-recognized Native American tribes provides an update on the work of tribal governments in the state and shares their legislative priorities. Representative John Macco (R-Ledgeview) released the following statement:

"The Oneida Nation has been – and continues to be – an integral part of our Green Bayarea community. They have been an active supporter of the University of Wisconsin – Green Bay, which is located in the 88<sup>th</sup> Assembly District, by generating over \$240,000 for joint programming," said Rep. Macco.

"I am pleased that Chairman Hill was selected to give the Wisconsin State of the Tribes address to the legislature. I look forward to continuing to work with him and his colleagues in the future," concluded Rep. Macco.
