Republicans Celebrate 52nd Month of Not Expanding Medicaid by Stripping it From the Budget

Fitchburg – Yesterday evening, Wisconsin Republicans announced that they were stripping the Medicaid expansion from the state budget. Rep. Anderson released the following statement:

"It was fitting that on May 1st, the 52nd month that Wisconsin could have expanded BadgerCare to 82,000 people, Wisconsin Republicans announced that they were stripping the provision from the budget. Wisconsinites support expanding Medicaid because they know how important it is to have quality healthcare.
