## **Rep. Neubauer Statement on Budget Listening Session**

MADISON – Today, Representative Greta Neubauer (D-Racine) released the following statement regarding her budget listening session with Senator Bob Wirth, Representative Tip McGuire, and Representative Bob Wittke, held on Monday, June 3, 2019 at Gateway Technical College in Racine:

“I was so honored that over 40 community members took the time from their busy evening to speak with us about their priorities in the People’s Budget. It is clear that Racinians care deeply about accepting the Medicaid expansion, funding our public schools, criminal justice reform, and finding sustainable solutions to our transportation issues.

“It’s critical that we engage in bipartisan discussions on these issues, and I am hopeful that conversations like these will lead my Republican colleagues to consider solutions that further support the needs of the people of Wisconsin.

“I am grateful that so many people in our community are engaged on these issues and want to hold their legislators accountable.
