SUSPECT ARRESTED ON 8TH OWI

Milwaukee, **WI** – (**June 13**th, **2019**) The Milwaukee County Sheriff's Office (MCSO), works around the clock to keep our freeway systems safe from intoxicated drivers. Operating While Intoxicated is a serious offense that turns a vehicle into a weapon and other motorists into targets.

On Sunday, June 9th, 2019, at approximately 11:34 a.m., a Deputy Sheriff responded to a one car vehicle crash, southbound on I43 at Maple St. The vehicle was pinned against the driver's side and the concrete wall. The driver, Begoll Azizi, was unresponsive but breathing. Mr. Begoll exhibited signs of an opioid overdose. The Deputy Sheriff administered two doses of Narcan. Mr. Begoll was arrested for Operating While Intoxicated – 8th Offense, a Class F Felony carrying a fine not to exceed \$25,000 or imprisonment not to exceed 12 years and 6 months, or both.

Chief Deputy Sheriff Denita Ball reminds the public, "Those who endanger lives by Operating While Intoxicated will be arrested. Those who repeat this dangerous choice will face serious felony charges."
