Rep. Sanfelippo's DOT Reform Bills Pass the Assembly

MADISON, Wis. – The State Assembly passed Assembly Bills <u>273</u>, <u>275</u>, <u>284</u> and <u>285</u> authored by Rep. Sanfelippo, R-New Berlin. The legislation will reform the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (DOT) to help it operate more effectively and efficiently.

"I appreciate the support of my colleagues who voted in favor of these bills, as well as the time and effort put in by industry stakeholders who helped us craft these very important reforms," Rep. Sanfelippo said.

Rep. Sanfelippo <u>introduced several other bills</u> as part of the <u>Road to Sustainability Package</u> (RSP). The RSP is a group of bills that require meaningful operational reforms to improve department-wide efficiency.

"These bills will save taxpayer money and ensure our dollars are being spent wisely," said Rep. Sanfelippo.

The 2017 audit on the State Highway Program was the catalyst for these bills being drafted.

"I will continue to work with legislators, industry stakeholders, the DOT, and the governor to improve department efficiencies - ensuring government does not waste taxpayer money is not a partisan issue and shouldn't be politicized," Rep. Sanfelippo said.
