**MADISON** – The Wisconsin State Assembly passed Assembly Bill 250, authored by Representative Ken Skowronski (R-Franklin), during an Assembly floor session this afternoon. AB 250 makes changes to the current licensing system for sign language and deaf language interpreters.
