Milwaukee County Clerk Christenson Offers Free Passport Photos on September 18th in Honor of Passport Day in the USA

Milwaukee, WI - In recognition of "Passport Day in the USA" Milwaukee County Clerk George Christenson is offering free passport photos – a \$10 value – to Milwaukee County residents who submit a new passport application in the County Clerk's office this Wednesday, September 18th. The office is located in Room 105 of the County Courthouse (901 N. 9th Street) and applications can be submitted from 8:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

"If you're planning a trip to a destination where a passport is required, apply for your passport and take advantage of our free photo offer on Wednesday, September 18," Christenson said.

Passport application forms are available in the County Clerk's office or may be downloaded from the U.S. Department of State website at: **travel.state.gov**

Passport applicants must bring in a certified birth certificate and a valid government issued photo identification card, such as a driver's license. The cost of a passport is \$145 for adults and \$115 for children under the age of 16.

All persons applying for a passport, including children, must be present during the application process. Both parents must sign the application of a passport for a child under the age of 16.
