## **BLS Data: Wisconsin Adds 12,300 Private-Sector, 11,400 Non-Farm Jobs Over Year**

MADISON – The Department of Workforce Development (DWD) today released the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics (BLS) preliminary employment estimates for the month of September. The data shows that Wisconsin added 12,300 private-sector and 11,400 total non-farm jobs from September 2018 to September 2019. Wisconsin's labor force participation rate remained at 67.2 percent in September, while the state's unemployment rate in September was 3.2 percent. The national unemployment rate for September 2019 was 3.5 percent.

- **Place of Residence Data:** Wisconsin's labor force participation rate remained at 67.2 percent in September, 4.0 percent higher than the national rate of 63.2 percent. Wisconsin's unemployment rate in September was 3.2 percent, 0.3 percent lower than the national rate of 3.5 percent.
- **Place of Work Data:** Wisconsin added 12,300 private-sector and 11,400 total non-farm jobs from September 2018 to September 2019. From August 2019 to September 2019 Wisconsin added 1,900 private-sector and 3,000 total non-farm jobs,

"September's labor numbers emphasize the importance that our programming and policies prioritize economic growth for all Wisconsin families and businesses," DWD Secretary-designee Caleb Frostman said. "With Wisconsin's current unemployment rate and the continued workforce shortage, we must ensure all Wisconsinites earn family-supporting wages and benefits. We will continue to enhance our programming to meet the needs of the Wisconsin workforce."
