Officer John Hetland Honored as First Responder of the Year

RACINE — Today, the Wisconsin State Assembly honored First Responders of the Year for districts from across Wisconsin as Hometown Heroes during the Assembly's floor session. Officer John Hetland, who passed away earlier this year intervening in an armed robbery, was selected as the First Responder of the Year for the 66th Assembly District, which includes much of the City of Racine.
