**Department of Revenue unveils online filing system for local governments at
Wisconsin Towns Association annual convention**

MyDORGov simplifies reporting for local government officials

MADISON - Yesterday, Wisconsin Department of Revenue (DOR) Secretary Peter Barca unveiled DOR's online filing system for local governments. MyDORGov's prototype was announced in late March. The system's portal design has many benefits that make it easier for local government officials to securely access and electronically file required forms and meet DOR's State and Local Finance Division's filing deadlines.

Enhancements, based on customer feedback after beta testing MyDORGov, make it easier for those who file on behalf of multiple districts to manage required forms. Additionally, office holders can more easily view and modify the access of others who may file on their behalf.

Addressing members of the Wisconsin Towns Association in Wisconsin Dells, Secretary Barca noted, "Our goal is to make it easier and more secure for you to file forms with the Department of Revenue."

- Forms are organized specific to a role (ex: clerk, treasurer)
- Form access is assigned/approved
- Multiple forms are more easily managed
- Contact information is directly updated
- Access to forms is more secure

The only forms not yet available on the portal are the financial reports that are filed by Clerks. They will be added in January of 2020.
