Rep. Considine Bill Advances to Governor's Desk

Madison – Last night, the Wisconsin State Senate heard and passed Assembly Bill 77. This legislation was authored by Representative Dave Considine (D-Baraboo) and it designates a portion of State Highway 33 as the Staff Sergeant (SSG) Daniel D. Busch Memorial Highway.
