Hometown Hero Honored

Madison--State Representative John Nygren (R-Marinette), released the following statement after presenting Eloise Massee with the "Hometown Hero" award:

"Today I had the distinct privilege of honoring Eloise Massee on the floor of the State Assembly with the "Hometown Hero" award.

Eloise is one of two statewide honorees for the Prudential Spirit of Community Award for charity and service. Eloise is currently an eighth-grader and serves as co-chair of a committee at her school that raises funds and awareness to promote life-saving organ donations and conducts community services projects. She has volunteered for several years at the public library's summer reading program, science and engineering camps, and holiday dance clinics for students with special needs.

This year, Eloise also served as co-chair of her school's Northeast Wisconsin Donate Life and Community Service Committee, recruiting volunteers, registering new donors, advertising, and coordinating with a national organ donation organization for the annual walk to raise money. She also has hosted a "Heavenly Hats Parade" which provides hats for cancer patients and has made plans to launch an annual toy and book drive.

"I would like to thank Eloise for her service to our most vulnerable. At such a young age, she has displayed a sense of community that most won't achieve in a lifetime. She has a bright future and I'm sure will continue to make Wisconsin proud for years to come."
