# BLS Data: Wisconsin Unemployment Rate, Labor Force Participation Rate Remain Unchanged in November

MADISON – The Department of Workforce Development (DWD) today released the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics (BLS) preliminary employment estimates for the month of November. The data shows that Wisconsin's unemployment rate remained at 3.3 percent in November, while the labor force participation rate also remained unchanged at 67.1 percent. The data also showed that Wisconsin has added 9,900 private-sector jobs from November 2018 to November 2019.

- Place of Residence Data: Wisconsin's labor force participation rate in November was 67.1, 3.9 percent higher than the national rate of 63.2 percent. Wisconsin's unemployment rate in November was 3.3 percent, 0.2 percent lower than the national rate of 3.5 percent.
- Place of Work Data: Wisconsin added 9,900 private-sector and 6,500 total non-farm jobs from November 2018 to November 2019. From October 2019 to November 2019 Wisconsin's private-sector and total non-farm jobs declined by 1,200 and 2,900 respectively.

"Wisconsin's unemployment rate remained steady at 3.3% last month, and we look forward to working with our statewide partners over the next year to continue to create workforce initiatives that increase wages and encourage family-supporting jobs," said DWD Secretary-designee Caleb Frostman.
