Speaker Vos Releases GOP Weekly Radio Address

Madison...Speaker Robin Vos (R-Rochester) delivers this week's GOP radio address. Much was accomplished in the legislature in 2019 and we look forward to an even better 2020.

I'm Assembly Speaker Robin Vos. As we welcome a new year, I want to take a moment to look back at 2019 and how much the legislature accomplished on behalf of the people of Wisconsin.

Our biggest accomplishment was passing a conservative budget and the governor signing it into law, despite all Democrats in the legislature voting no. Republicans took the governor's liberal wish list that raised taxes and expanded welfare and focused on the real needs of the state: education, workforce development, and health care.

Despite what you hear in the media, there has been widespread bipartisanship in the legislature. Ninetyfive percent of the votes in the Assembly were bipartisan and all the new laws had bipartisan support.

In the New Year, we'll continue working on the legislation from the three Speaker's Task Forces this session. These task forces looked at improving water quality, preventing suicide, and removing barriers from the adoption process so children can more quickly find their forever homes. 2019 was a great year and I'm looking forward to an even better year for Wisconsin in 2020.
