Rock County Legislators Honor Chief Deputy Barb Tillman as Hometown Hero

Madison – Today, the Wisconsin State Assembly members representing Rock County honored recently retired Rock County Sheriff's Chief Deputy Barb Tillman as a Hometown Hero.

Representatives Deb Kolste (D-Janesville), Amy Loudenbeck (R-Clinton), Mark Spreitzer (D-Beloit) and Don Vruwink (D-Milton) presented her with the award during the Assembly floor session today.

Tillman retired in December after 37 years of service to Rock County. She is a trailblazer in every sense of the word. She was the first woman to hold the ranks of sergeant, lieutenant, captain, commander, and chief deputy in the Rock County Sheriff's office.
