Streckenbach Joins Packers, Extension to Feed Local Pantries

County Officials, Green Bay Packers Team Up for Brown County Potato Project

(Brown County, Wis.) – Brown County Executive Troy Streckenbach, along with Extension Community Gardens and the Green Bay Packers, will be distributing free seed potatoes to gardeners as part of the 'Planting for a Purpose Program' on Thursday, May 28th, at 11:00 a.m. at the STEM Innovation Center.

The purpose of Brown County Potato Project is for gardeners to sign up and receive free seed potatoes with the understanding that they agree to donate half of the potatoes harvested to local food pantries. There have been nearly 1,200 seed potatoes requested by people who will plant them this year. The potatoes have been provided by the Wisconsin Certified Potato Project.
