Abigail Lowery Announces She Will Be on the Ballot in November

DEFOREST, Wis. - Today DeForest Village Trustee Abigail Lowery announced that she has secured ballot access to be the sole Democratic candidate for the Wisconsin State Assembly in the 37th District. The 37th District includes parts of DeForest and Windsor as well as Columbus, Waterloo, and Watertown. This is Lowery's first time running for a state elected office.

"I am proud to be the first formal Democratic challenger to our current State Representative in four years," Lowery said. "I collected a total of 388 valid signatures, well above the 200 needed to get on the ballot for a State Assembly candidate. Signatures were collected from parts of all four counties that make up the district. I want to thank all the people in the 37th District that signed my nomination forms and helped to bring choice to the ballot this fall.

The ability to choose your elected officials is a value I hold dearly. During my reelection bid for the DeForest Village Board, I encouraged others to run against me on the ballot because I believe elections hold officials accountable to the people. No elected official should be guaranteed a reelection. I look forward to meeting people from across the 37th District and earning their vote to be their voice in the Wisconsin State Legislature."

Lowery is a lifelong Wisconsinite. She and her family have lived in the 37th district for over a decade. She is a UW-Madison graduate, former special education teacher, and has worked in a range of positions supporting adults and children with developmental disabilities. Lowery and her husband have two children and a dog they lovingly adopted from the Columbia County Humane Society.
