



2019 BILL

1 **AN ACT relating to:** wage thresholds for receipt of unemployment insurance
2 benefits.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, a claimant for unemployment insurance benefits is generally ineligible to receive any benefits for a week if the claimant receives wages or other amounts from employment totaling more than \$500. This bill suspends this provision from the effective date of the bill until June 30, 2021.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 **SECTION 1. Nonstatutory provisions.**

4 (1) WAGE THRESHOLD. Section 108.05 (3) (dm) does not apply to a claimant who
5 files for benefits for a week beginning on or after the effective date of this subsection
6 and before June 30, 2021.
