Mason Becker Responds to Governor Evers' Emergency Order
"It's based on science, and necessary to bring our lives back to normal"

Fort Atkinson, WI: Yesterday, State Representative Cody Horlacher expressed his "extreme opposition" to Governor Tony Evers' Emergency Order calling for widespread use of face masks in Wisconsin's public spaces. Horlacher also referred to the governor as "Dictator Evers."

33rd Assembly District Candidate Mason Becker said today that Representative Horlacher's position is indeed "extreme," given the medical and scientific community's clear insistence that the data is clear: wearing masks in indoor spaces is necessary to gain control of a dangerous virus and allow our economy to fully reopen.

"I support Governor Evers' order," Becker said. "It's based on science and necessary to bring our lives back to normal. In order to protect the health and safety of Wisconsin residents, and to make sure Wisconsin workers and students, and all of us, can resume the lives we knew before this virus upended our lives, we need to wear masks. As a small business owner, I understand that for our local economies to return to normalcy, we need to get this deadly pandemic under control. We also need to stop the further spread before our children are back in school."

"Freedom isn't free," Becker added. "Our parents and grandparents made many sacrifices during World War II in order to defeat the fascist Axis. We've all heard the stories of those sacrifices. The least we can do is wear a mask."
