(Madison, WI) – Today the Wisconsin Association of Health Plans (WAHP) announced that former State Rep. John Nygren accepted the position of Executive Director for the organization. He will officially join the Association later this month.

Farrow also again thanked outgoing Association CEO, Nancy Wenzel, as she completes her tenure with WAHP. Wenzel announced her intent to retire in early 2020, but then delayed her retirement to help lead WAHP through the tumultuous early days of the COVID-19 pandemic.

"Nancy and I have worked together on health insurance issues in Wisconsin for well over 25 years," Farrow said. "It is with very mixed emotions that I thank my good friend for her service as leader of the Association. Consumers in Wisconsin are far better off as a result of her community-minded advocacy when it comes to public policy. Her voice will be greatly missed."
