**Republican Legislators Double-Down
on Election Conspiracy Theories**

MADISON — Today, the Committee on Campaigns and Elections, led by Legislative Republicans, elected to hold an invite-only public hearing to provide a forum for false claims regarding voter fraud in the 2020 November Election. Rep. Greta Neubaauer (D-Racine) released the following statement in response:

“Today’s hearing made it clear that Republican legislative leadership has chosen to double-down on debunked conspiracy theories and plots aimed at delegitimizing Wisconsin’s election process. If this hearing was truly meant to discuss the facts about the November election, committee leadership should have invited the public servants who have devoted their time and careers to safeguarding our elections, or the experts who have investigated and debunked the false allegations surrounding the November election.

“The people of Wisconsin chose Joe Biden as the next president of the United States. The Trump campaign’s election challenges in Wisconsin have failed at every level and in every court ruling so far. Instead of wasting our time and taxpayer money on this disgraceful display, the Wisconsin Legislature should be meeting to address our urgent need for COVID-19 relief.”
