Representative Snyder Begins Third Term in the Legislature

Rep. Snyder inaugurated as Legislature reopens the Capitol

Madison... Representative Patrick Snyder (Schofield) took the oath of office to begin his third term as Representative for the 85th Assembly District on Monday. Following the Inauguration Ceremony and vote to reopen the State Capitol, Representative Snyder made the following statement:

"I am honored to have been chosen by my friends and neighbors in the 85th Assembly District to represent them in Madison during the 105th Legislature of the State Assembly. It is now more important than ever that legislators work to bipartisan solutions to COVID-19.
