Rep. Emerson: Statement on Election of Edmund Manydeeds III as President of UW Board of Regents

MADISON –Today, the University of Wisconsin System Board of Regents elected Regent Edmund Manydeeds III to a one-year term as president. Manydeeds, a graduate of UW-Superior and UW-Madison, succeeds Andrew S. Petersen, who has served as president since June 2019. Representative Jodi Emerson (D-Eau Claire) released the following statement in response:
