Rep. Cabral-Guevara Votes for a Forward-Thinking Budget

Madison, WI - Representative Rachael Cabral-Guevara (R-Fox Crossing) voted yesterday evening in favor of the state budget proposal. After the vote, Rep. Cabral-Guevara released the following statement:

“Last night, I was proud to cast a vote in favor of a budget that makes critical investments in healthcare, transportation, and education,” said Rep. Cabral-Guevara. “Not only does this bipartisan budget put historic funding levels into several key areas, but it does so as we cut taxes for folks across the state.”

Recent estimates have the state looking at \$4.4 billion in additional revenues over three years. Some of this will end up in the rainy day fund, but most of it will be sent back to families and businesses. Some highlights from this budget include:

- \$3.4 billion in income and property tax relief
- Drastically increasing nursing home and dental reimbursement rates
- \$125 million for broadband infrastructure
- \$100 million for the local road program
- Achieving 2/3rds funding for our schools
- \$5 million to launch the Nurse Educators Program
- \$2.5 million to expand the Treatment Alternatives and Diversion Program

“After listening to folks from around the district, I am confident these investments will have positive real-world impacts. Ultimately, this budget helps Wisconsinites in every corner of the state, and I am hopeful that the governor will sign this forward-thinking budget into law,” said Rep. Cabral-Guevara.
