## Wimberger Votes to Cut Taxes and Help Wisconsin Families

MADISON, WI – State Senator Eric Wimberger (R – Green Bay) released the following statement after voting for the bipartisan Wisconsin State budget bill which lowers taxes and invests in helping Wisconsin families:
