

Governor Evers Vetoes Bill that Passed Senate Floor 29-1

Madison, WI – On Friday afternoon, in an effort to avoid attention, Governor Evers quietly vetoed Assembly Bill 293 which would have made Wisconsin a 2nd Amendment sanctuary state. This legislation had bi-partisan support in both chambers, including a 29-1 vote on the Senate floor. Senator Mary Felzkowski (R-Tomahawk), an author of this bill, provided the following statement:

"Wisconsinites want assurances that they're going to be able to protect their families with the rights afforded to them by the U.S. Constitution, regardless of which party controls Washington D.C. I know that, you know that, Republicans and Democrats in the Legislature know that, but apparently Governor Evers does not. He vetoed a bill that twenty-nine of thirty-three state senators voted in favor of. That's not governing for the greater good of Wisconsin, that's cowtowing to the private interests that fund his campaign. I'm very disappointed in the Governor's decision."
