Toney Campaign Releases Fundraising Report Law Enforcement Lining Up Behind Toney

[Fond du Lac, WI...] Fond du Lac County District Attorney Eric Toney today released his campaign finance report in his bid to become the next attorney general in Wisconsin and said more and more law enforcement support has joined his team.

Toney said:

"After focusing nearly all of our effort on lining up the support of Wisconsin's front line cops and prosecutors, today our campaign filed our campaign finance report. My opponents may have raised more money because they are part of the Madison elite, but I have the cops and prosecutors who put their lives on the line for our families. I'm the only candidate in the race that's a career prosecutor locking up violent criminals."

Toney will follow in the model of former Attorney General Brad Schimel and put fighting crime at the top of his list to keep our streets safe.

More than 50 sheriffs, district attorneys, and police chiefs have endorsed Toney's campaign. He also has the unanimous endorsement of the Wisconsin Fraternal Order of Police.

Toney said, "When I announced my candidacy for attorney general, I pledged to restore law and order, prosecute crime and defend Wisconsin's election laws. Now, more than ever, it's time to send a prosecutor — not a politician — to be our next 'Top Cop."
