Rep. Vorpagel Votes to Override Governor's Harmful Veto

Madison- State Representative Tyler Vorpagel (R-Plymouth) issued the following today's Floor Session to override the Governor's veto on AB 336.

"Wisconsin businesses are facing massive worker shortages. Every day businesses are shutting their doors or limiting hours and services because they cannot find help. Local business are offering more than double the minimum wage and are still unable to fill positions. Today the Assembly held a vote to override Governor Evers' veto and join 26 other states in ending the enhanced federal unemployment benefits early, getting more people into our workforce and off unemployment.

"After the Governor vetoed this legislation I heard from business across the district who are in dire need for workers. Today we offered our Democratic colleagues the opportunity to join us in supporting our small businesses who need help as they recover from the past 17 months. It frustrates me that not one of them could put the needs of their constituents above politics and do what was right for Wisconsin."
